- 1. 10:45: Meeting Called to Order by Dennis Christie (DC)
- 2. 10:45-10:49: ASHRAE Chapter Logo
 - a. Prior to BOG meeting DC had emailed out information on the new ASHRAE logo, including design guidelines, color choices, etc.
 - b. All board members had an opportunity to review the documents prior to the meeting, and suggest a logo design and color.
 - c. Cindy Hyatt (CH) suggested the vertical design, green lettering, bold chapter name.
 - d. Heather Schopplein (HS) suggested horizontal design, Barbados blue lettering, bold chapter name.
 - e. General discussion on horizontal versus vertical and color.
 - f. Motion by Jennifer Felsburg (JF) motioned to have the San Diego logo in the horizontal format, with bold chapter name, and Barbados blue lettering.

 - ii. Approved Unanimously
- 3. 10:50: General Business
 - a. Review of January BOG Meeting Minutes
 - i. No comments
 - ii. Motion by CH to approve January meeting
 minutes
 - 1. Seconded by Hugh Egan (HE)
 - 2. Approved Unanimously
- 4. 10:50-11:35: Parliamentary Procedure by CH
 - a. CH passed out hand outs on Robert's Rules of Order/Parliamentary Procedure to all present.

- b. Parliamentary procedure has a fixed agenda, which we follow closely. Our only difference is that we wait to make announcements at the chapter meeting.
- c. Quorum, according to the bylaws, is 2/3 of the board to have a meeting with voting on motions (to be able to present motions).
- d. To pass a motion we only need majority approval.
- e. Our board is currently 9 members (with Dan Noto and Bruce Brown moving out of town). Therefore we need 6 board members to be able to present motions at meetings.
- f. Procedure for motions
 - i. Present motion (include suggested outcome)
 - ii. Second motion
 - iii. Debate motion
 - iv. Subsidiary Motion (if applicable)
 - v. Vote on motions*
 - Cannot vote on a motion until all amendments/subsidiary motions have been addressed.
- q. Motion example 1:
 - i. Person X Proposes a motion
 - ii. Chair calls for a second
 - iii. Person Y Seconds the motion
 - iv. Chair asks for discussion on said motion
 - v. Chair calls for a vote on motion
 - vi. Majority vote "yes" approves motion as
 proposed
- h. Motion example 2:
 - i. Person X Proposes a motion
 - ii. Chair calls for a second
 - iii. Person Y Seconds the motion
 - iv. Chair asks for discussion on said motion
 - v. Person Z motions to amend motion
 - vi. Chair asks for discussion on said amendment
 - vii. Chair calls for a vote on amended motion
 - viii. If majority of board approved amended motion, said amended motion now becomes the main motion
 - ix. Chair asks for additional discussion on motion
 - x. Chair calls for a vote on motion
 - xi. Majority vote "yes" approves motion
- i. Motion example 3:
 - i. Person X Proposes a motion
 - ii. Chair calls for a second
 - iii. Person Y Seconds the motion
 - iv. Chair asks for discussion on said motion
 - v. Chair calls for a "if no objection..." we can pass the motion (on general consent)



- j. General Guidelines (to be both at our meetings and at CRC)
 - Laying a motion on the table (can come back to the motion later in the meeting or at the next meeting)
 - ii. Laying a motion to postpone indefinitely (allows members to dispose a motion without agreeing or disagreeing to it). The motion can be re-presented/re-written and proposed at another meeting
- k. There is a copy of these rules, guidelines, etc on the website.
- 1. We should consider re-reviewing these procedures at our next planning meeting for potential new board members.
